





The Swann Wynd Bridge house is in a wooded setting on an outcropping in the bend of a small creek. An attached footbridge crosses the creek, and together with the house, anchors a pedestrian cobblestone road lined with houses that is inspired by the character of English hamlets in the Cotswolds. It is designed for ecologically conscious clients with a focus on community and an active lifestyle. The design of the four-bedroom, three-and-a-half bath house offers the full range of homeowner experiences on the small one-tenth-acre lot while also serving the pedestrian scale of the community. The design combines efficient space-planning with generous details such as an open-stair hall, 12-foot vaulted ceilings, numerous large windows and tranquil outdoor spaces. The 2,475-square-foot house (with a 1,168-square-foot finished basement) is inspired by English countryside living but crafted with local materials. The building forms are based on European vernacular principles such as steep roof pitches and narrow building masses. The expression is intentionally simple, and the material palette is minimalist and balanced. The challenge of meeting the need for privacy in a close-knit community (including a public right-of-way attached to the house itself) required significant thought. Layers of architectural massing run parallel to the bridge and serve as the primary public expression, while shielding the more private parts of the house from public view. The main floor of the house is elevated eight feet from the bridge surface, giving occupants of the house a height advantage over the outside pedestrians and fostering a sense of pleasant separation. However, the living room functions like a traditional porch: residents can open the large windows and engage with the outside world, or close them for privacy.

Winfield Gate is a beautifully crafted, London-style development that seeks to evoke the stately lines of Winfield House, the ambassador's residence in London. Located in the heart of the highly desirable River Oaks neighborhood and situated near top boutiques, restaurants and art galleries, Winfield Gate is only 10 minutes to downtown Houston or the Galleria. The residences at Winfield Gate embody attention to detail and a high finish level. Limited to only 1.3 acres, the builder was able to construct 20 four- and five-level townhomes with an average sales price of \$1.9 million. Fourteen of the 20 homes were pre-sold before breaking ground to the target market of affluent Baby Boomers becoming empty nesters. A spacious elevator accesses all floors of each multi-story townhome. Winfield Gate was designed meticulously for the sophisticated urbanite's desires for gracious living, easy entertaining and elegant spaces, without the concerns of time-consuming property maintenance. From the lush, central courtyard and fountain, to the privacy wall with guarded entry, each richly appointed residence has been designed with the finest materials and every amenity in mind, creating the city's most unique and desirable townhome community.

Two siblings who had inherited their childhood home decided to retire from different areas of the country to live there together. They sought to update and modernize the home while still retaining its original character. The project involved a complete renovation and an addition to accommodate their aging needs. The original home, constructed about 50 years ago, had never been updated. All mechanical, plumbing, and electrical systems were replaced and updated to current code requirements. The renovation of the family room incorporated some of the original knotty pine into the design, and many of the original knotty pine interior doors were also retained. The dining room and kitchen were completely renovated to better connect to the rest of the open floor plan, and a large island was added to become a gathering space. Additional windows were added to increase natural lighting. New additions were constructed with separate master suites customized for each sibling and a media room. Exterior terraces with a fire pit were added to the rear of the home. This area is now a single level and can be easily

Heritage Sands is Cape Cod's first new oceanfront cottage community in more than 50 years. The eight-acre site was formerly a seasonal trailer park that hosted 150 recreational vehicles and 15 cottages on cement slabs. The developers harnessed the opportunity to work within Cape Cod's seasonal cottage zoning ordinance to create an elegant, high-density cottage community reminiscent of the Cape's

historic seasonal neighborhoods. The Cape has a rich history of summer

communities populated by families returning year after year. This tradition began with tent sites and evolved over time to dense cottage neighborhoods, a land plan vernacular that was unique to the Cape. The development team endeavored to use this unique model, instead of carving the site up into a handful of luxury waterfront "trophy homes." The goal was to leverage technological developments such as modular homebuilding, energy efficiency, and stormwater compliance with tried-and-true strategies for traditional neighborhood design, including ample front porches

The result is a highly unique community that has a rich sense of place. Cottages are clustered around common greens to create "pocket neighborhoods," and crushed shell paths wind down to over 600 feet of private

and shared common space.

beach. A community clubhouse and pool are available to host larger family functions or a quick workout. The interiors were designed to maximize the small footprints of each of the ten cottage prototypes in this neighborhood of 63 homes. Homes range in size from 900 to 1,350 square feet. The one-and-a-half story compact floor plans combine tall, lofty ceilings with smaller private rooms. The design intent was to achieve an upscale, but relaxed, feel through simple craftsmanship. In an effort to deliver exceptional quality, minimize site impacts and limit disturbance to residents, the team used off-site modular production for the homes.

This modern master suite sought to create the perfect haven, where elegance coexists with functionality for the family it was designed to nurture. The many hues of grey tones seek to evoke the beauty of nature. The interior designer introduced the architect, builder and owner to distinctive architectural details integrated with features sought by the owners. A requirement of the space was to create a sleeping and seating area in the master bedroom, which has dramatic high ceilings and large windows. The sleeping area is defined by a recessed cove ceiling detail. To create a tranquil, zen-like setting to relax and sleep, the master bedroom is appointed with monochromatic comfort in both color and furniture. A custom accent bed wall in warm, grey, wood tones with antiqued mirrors, and a rich, upholstered wall panel using varied textures adds interest. There is also a convenient breakfast bar in the master suite. Porcelain wood flooring is used in the bedroom, and white glass, tiled flooring in the master bathroom. Entering the master bathroom through double doors, the bathtub and feature art wall provide a focal point amongst the his and hers pairs of water closets, vanities and closets.



The cottage-style Craftsman exterior with cedar-shake siding, rustic, reclaimed barn timbers and handmade cement tiles and countertops add unique architectural accents to this home. Gorgeously crafted warehouse style doors open to a climatecontrolled wine room. A Marvin bi-folding door with Phantom Screen opens the sunroom to the outdoors. This five-bedroom. six-bath home also features white oak hardwood floors and lofted ladders in the children's suites. The home contains a whole house backup generator, reverse-osmosis water purification system and notable green features like geothermal heating and cooling. Full-home automation allows home owners to turn lights on and off, control heating and cooling and enjoy

> audio and video, plus have access to security, cameras, door locks, and irrigation from a cell phone. Other amenities include a 566-square-foot art studio, boathouse with cantilevered deck and a three-car garage.

High up in the treetops in Robbinsville, N.C., this mountainside retreat has 30-mile views of Lake Fontana, the surrounding forest, and the Blue Ridge and Great Smoky Mountains. The site is surrounded by large stands of old-growth trees. The home is designed on a 600-square-foot footprint for minimal impact on the surrounding forest. Top-notch arborists were brought in to protect the trees and woodland during construction. The structure is covered with a colorful metal-panel siding system that transforms the mountainside home into a modern, yet rusticlooking cabin for the 21st century.

The challenge was designing and building for an extreme sloping site. The result is quite dramatic. The three-story home is 1,737 square feet, with two bedrooms, two-and-a-half bathrooms, generous balcony space, and a 168-square-foot, upper-level loft. Recycled wood was used throughout the cabin, including repurposed bowling alley lanes used as countertops. The lowest floor is comprised of the two-car garage, bedroom with en-suite bath, sliding

> glass doors, and an 85-square-foot deck. The second floor is the primary living space, which encompasses the family area, kitchen, dining area and powder room. This main level features massive windows. a sculptural, reflecting, floating staircase with cable railing, and a large wrap-around deck measuring 658 square feet. The upper level features the master bedroom, master bath, walk-in closet, and private balcony. The top of the upper level features a loft comprised of sliding glass doors and surrounded by a balcony that is perfect for taking in the scenic views from the highest level. This net-zero energy home uses solar power, a rainwater catchment system that supplies all the water, and ultra energyefficient, thermal-clad windows and doors, LEED Platinum certification is pending.

The client's original vision for their new Lake Michigan residence was for a vacation home large enough to accommodate their extended family, but with all the intimacy of a lakeside cottage. This challenge was met through a combination of thoughtful planning, innovative design and diligent execution. The final result is a meticulously crafted beachfront retreat that reinforces the beauty of its natural landscape. Flowing off a long, private drive, the property is lined with mature trees and lavish landscaping. A one-story carriage house sits out in front, allowing the massing to build up to the two-story main house beyond. Upon entering, expansive Lake Michigan views and sunlight flood the free-flowing design of the first floor, while large pocket doors are incorporated to close off rooms and encourage intimate occasions as well. The second floor offers additional opportunities for guest and family lounging in the common sitting room, nestled between two master suites and three junior suites. Durable materials and energy-efficient components were incorporated throughout the construction of this seasonal residence. Inside, a closed-loop geothermal HVAC system, spray-foam-insulated building envelope and LED lighting limit energy consumption and provide the owners minimal upkeep year-round. On the exterior, a maintenance-friendly combination of board-and-batten Versatex siding, clad windows with Low-E3 SmartSun glass and handsome stonework offer extra protection against heavy lakefront winds and bitter Michigan winters. On mild summer nights, children can enjoy camping out on the lakeside sleeping porch. The lower level adds to the vacation amenities with a recreation room, bar and gym. Outside, just steps away from Lake Michigan's breathtaking shoreline, one can admire spectacular lake views and sunsets while lounging by the fire pit in the backyard's ultra-remote outdoor entertaining space.



The Lake Club is the social and recreational heart of The Lakes at Centerra, a 255-acre residential community oriented to outdoor enthusiasts. The property includes two buildings, the Community Building and the Pool Pavilion, with a pool and playground. The 1,753-square-foot Community Building serves as a meeting and party place for the community under a layered wood ceiling. The expansive windows enhance the indoor/outdoor experience and provide vistas of the lakes. A small kitchen for events and cooking demonstrations is the centerpiece of the interior, while a two-sided fireplace anchors the opposite end of the room. A fire pit on the terrace that faces the lake provides a place for residents to decompress at the end of the day. The 1,146-square-foot Pool Pavilion provides welcome shade, restrooms, and a place to stow gear. The pool is reminiscent of a "swimming hole" and includes both lap swimming and water features oriented to young children. The rhythmic timber structural system and low-sloping metal roofs of the buildings are modern in expression, yet evoke the agricultural structures that are common in the area. The main pedestrian axis from the community splits the two buildings and terminates on the fishing dock. The broad overhangs progressively grow in dimension closer to the pedestrian way, providing protection for the outdoor seating areas. The Lake Club also serves as a trailhead for several miles of trails through natural open space that is under the stewardship of the High Plains Environmental Center.

Take 200 feet of Lake Tahoe beach front property, incorporate some of the original cabins that were used to house athletes in the 1960 Winter Olympic Games at Squaw Valley, and a team of creative and passionate minds, and 22 months later you have a home that captures the vision and history of Sierra Nevada living. The opportunity to integrate lake activities and nestle the home in the native environment sparked the design concept for this beautiful property. There are two piers for easy water access and living spaces that accommodate both small, intimate family settings and large extended gatherings. The residence takes advantage of lakeview corridors from every room and seamless indoor/outdoor integration with strategically placed windows and retractable, sliding-glass door panels. The desire to utilize reclaimed materials for exterior and interior finishes resulted in sourcing from naval ship yards in California, to barns in Pennsylvania, to heavy timbers from British Columbia. Each of these elements grounds the home in the historical feel of old-world Lake Tahoe and gives it a warmth and charm often missing in much of today's modern architecture. The massing of the home downplays the size and harmonizes with the surrounding environment. Interior furnishings provide comfort and a traditional Tahoe appeal. From the early planning stages to the custom-built furniture pieces, this home embraces the timelessness of a Lake Tahoe retreat.

Bar Triangle Ranch reflects a pioneer spirit, maximizing views while maintaining intimacy by using exceptional, but simple, materials. Historic timber, native stone and forged iron complement the rustic setting while taking advantage of local and recycled building products. All stone was harvested on location. Hand-crafted lintels and L-shaped corners create the illusion of massing found in 19th-century buildings. The design centered the project on "the silo"—a round dining room—that reflects old grain storage structures. Great care was taken dismantling, relocating, and reconstructing a circa-1830 log cabin to incorporate it into the project as the living room. Custom millwork and hand-crafted finishes reflect the attention to detail. With boards up to 20 inches wide, salvaged, hand-scraped hardwood floors add warmth to the home. A vintage windmill head was transformed into a ceiling fan for the living room, with corrugated tin ceilings. Cast-iron air registers, push-button light switches and half-round gutters complement the turn-of-century details. The adjacent "barn" has 18-inch-thick stone walls that are 12 feet tall. All exposed wood is reclaimed, as is the antique wood-burning stove. The multi-purpose building acts as a garage, expands living space for large gatherings and has a cozy guest suite. Natural light floods the space through stainless steel overhead doors. Native landscaping, dual fuel HVAC, high efficiency glass and on-demand water heaters, in addition to spray-foam insulation and a deep western porch, reduce the home's demand on the environment.





A 17-story, LEED Gold-certified high rise with 250 affordable rental apartments, Celadon is the first development in California to combine 4 percent and 9 percent Low Income Housing Tax Credits vertically in a single building. Angled bays on the west side enhance views of the San Diego Bay. Twenty-five of the units are reserved for youth aging out of foster care and mentally ill adults at risk of homelessness, and 63 apartments are for seniors in a healthy residential living environment with community-based, onsite services. 





In the renovations to the home's addition from the 1960s, the kitchen was relocated to the center of the home to connect to the family room and create an open, modern floor plan, using materials consistent with the historical part of the home. The redesign accommodates modern needs such as additional closets and a mud room.

Heritage Sands is Cape Cod's first new oceanfront cottage community in more than 50 years. The eight-acre site was formerly a seasonal trailer park that hosted 150 recreational vehicles and 15 cottages on cement slabs. The developers harnessed the opportunity to work within Cape Cod's seasonal cottage zoning ordinance to create an elegant, high-density cottage community reminiscent of the Cape's historic seasonal neighborhoods. The goal was to leverage technological developments such as modular homebuilding, energy efficiency and storm compliance with tried-and-true strategies for traditional neighborhood design, including ample front porches and shared common space. The result is a highly unique community that has a rich sense of place. Cottages are clustered around common greens to create "pocket neighborhoods," and crushed shell paths wind down to over 600 feet of private beach.
